Healing we decided to send her a complimentary copy but from where had she got The Great Controversy? Another person said "Thank you" - before she had received the book, and another person sent a stamp to help with the postage. This is most welcome because it gives encouragement as well as being a help.

Printing equipment

We thank God that now we have our own electric guillotine which is capable of cutting over 500 sheets of paper at a time. This makes our print runs more efficient as we can do the batches of leaflets in higher quantities. We recently had given to us by another ministry a booklet maker; it takes the printed sheets and printed cover, staples

them and then folds the whole lot making a small booklet.

Booklets printed

1500 "Can Our Dead Speak To Us?" booklets and 1500 "Why Was Sin Permitted?" booklets have been printed, some have already been distributed at health exhibitions and some will be sent to another ministry in Kenya.

Please pray for the people who have received these booklets that they will come to know God through reading them. Recently we received 2 requests from people who had read the booklet Can Our Dead Speak to Us and had then requested The Great Controversy because they had first read this booklet. Praise the Lord.

125,000 leaflets out

We have had over 97 responses from the leaflets distributed by Royal Mail in Cornwall this includes one from the Isles of Scilly. We thank God for these and pray that there will be more from this area over the next months. Over 34 wanted postal Bible studies which another Ministry are sending to them every 2 weeks.

Next bulk mailing 276,000

Our next bulk mailing is planned for January, up in Scotland in the Aberdeen area and the Kinross area. This will be 276,000 leaflets, so again we ask you to pray for this project.
